## **Mazzuchelli Musings**

"Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of the bread." Lk. 24:35

7 hen Jesus disappeared from the disciples midst, what remained was Jesus in the Eucharist; the way he desires to remain with us. He said to the apostles at the Last Supper: "Do this in memory of me." Our faith is incarnational, which means it's fleshy; Jesus is still with us in the Eucharist. His presence in the Eucharist is different than his presence with us in creation; we don't say that this tree is Jesus, but we do say that about the Eucharist. There are many signs the Church uses to communicate to our senses that the invisible, although still real, truth that Jesus is present in the Eucharist. The Eucharist is protected by being reserved in a tabernacle made of solid valuable material kept locked. The Eucharist is also placed on or purified with linen which is a material that His body was wrapped in as a baby and in burial. We also take special care that any particles of the Eucharist don't drop to the floor by using communion patens, asking Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to rinse their fingers after distributing the Eucharist and similar practices. As much care that we take to protect Jesus' Eucharistic presence how much more care should we take to make sure the inside of the chalice is purified, namely; our souls. "That repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things." Lk. 24:48 Like the early apostles the Lord has called us to honor his presence among us in the breaking of the bread, not only by the way we treat the Eucharist but also by the way we strive to remain free from sin and invite others to repentance and holiness.

#### **Catholic Corner**

Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have." Luke 24:38–39

Imagine if Jesus appeared to you. Would you believe? Most likely you would, to a certain extent. It would be the beginning of an experience that could be life-changing, just as it was for these disciples.

In the first reading of today's Mass, Saint Peter is recorded as doing this very thing. After healing a crippled man at the gate of the Temple, a crowd gathered in amazement and Peter preached to them about Jesus. He concluded His sermon by saying, "God has thus brought to fulfillment what he had announced beforehand through the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ would suffer. Repent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be wiped away."

Saint Thomas Aquinas explains that the spiritual gift of understanding is a gift that reveals to us the very essence of God. He explains that it is a much deeper form of knowledge than that which is obtained through our five senses. Thus, simply seeing something with our eyes, touching it or hearing it is not nearly as convincing as the knowledge obtained through the spiritual gift of understanding. The gift of understanding enables us to "read inwardly" and to penetrate the very essence of something. For that reason, the physical appearance of Jesus might have been the first step toward believing, but it wasn't until these same disciples encountered our Lord within their souls, perceiving the very essence of His Resurrection inwardly, that they were forever changed. Only this form of knowledge could then convince them to go forth and proclaim the message of salvation.

Reflect, today, upon your own knowledge of Jesus and the transforming power of His Resurrection in your life. Has God spoken to you within the depths of your soul? Have you perceived this inward knowledge and had your mind opened? Listen attentively to our Lord—not just with your ears but primarily with your spirit. It is there, within you, that you, like the first disciples, will come to know and believe in the life, death and resurrection of Christ so that you can then go forth empowered to proclaim these truths to others.



## School and Religious Ed Financial Planning

Please join us for a brief presentation and conversation about our 3 Catholic schools and religious ed programs and the three year plan for how we will adapt the financial structures to our new reality as St. Dominic's Pastorate. We will have the same presentation on three different evenings, once at each school.

Tuesday April 2nd at 6:30pm at St. Joe's Church in the gathering space, Thursday April 11th at 6:30pm at St. Rose of Lima church in the Fr. Mazzuchelli Hall & April 16th at 5:30pm At HG-IC (Kieler campus Lower level)

This meeting will cover the current reality of each of the schools in our pastorate for both income and expenses. Then, we will delineate the financial structure we plan to adapt over a transition time of three years and request input for that plan. Finally, we will share a plan for a pastorate-wide Endowment Fund dedicated specifically to improving teacher salaries in each of our schools.

Please note: We do not anticipate any changes to the fundamental offerings of our academic programs. We have 3 great schools in our pastorate and the primary goal of this plan is to preserve them. This meeting will only cover adapting our accounting and financial structure. The experience of each student and parent in our schools should not be affected in any way by the content of this plan.


