Mazzuchelli Musings

 ${\mathcal B}$ lessed Divine Mercy Sunday to everyone. The Divine Mercy devotion is essential to knowing and loving Jesus Christ truly present in the Eucharist. "The Divine Mercy Message and Devotion" by Fr. Seraphim Michalenko, MIC states that, "Several times in her Diary, St. Faustina writes of seeing the red and pale rays coming, not from the Image, but from the Sacred Host; and once, as the priest exposed the Blessed Sacrament, she saw the rays from the Image pierce the Host and spread out from it all over the world (see 441). So too, with the eyes of faith, we should see in every Host the merciful Savior pouring Himself out as a fountain of mercy for us."

Saint Pope John Paul II established Divine Mercy to be celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter. In his Papal Letter The Lord's Day (Dies Domini), he renews the Church's teaching that participation in the Mass on Sunday is necessary for the good of humanity. "At Sunday Mass, Christians relive with particular intensity the experience of the Apostles on the evening of Easter when the Risen Lord appeared to them as they were gathered together (cf. Jn 20:19). In a sense, the People of God of all times were present in that small nucleus of disciples, the first fruits of the Church. Through their testimony, every generation of believers hears the greeting of Christ, rich with the messianic gift of peace, won by his blood and offered with his Spirit: "Peace be with you!" Christ's return among them "a week later" (Jn 20:26) can be seen as a radical prefiguring of the Christian community's practice of coming together every seven days, on "the Lord's Day" or Sunday, in order to profess faith in his Resurrection and to receive the blessing which he had promised: "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe" (Jn 20:29)."

I would invite the pastorate to read and reflect upon St. Pp. John Paul II's Letter, "The Lord's Day" and how we can both reclaim the Sabbath in our own lives and invite others to see the importance of reclaiming the Sabbath.

Catholic Corner

Divine Mercy Sunday–Solemnity

In the year 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized Saint Maria Faustina Kowolska and added the Feast of Divine Mercy to the Church's official calendar. Saint Faustina, who died in 1938, was a member of the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Krakow, Poland. She came from a simple and poor family of farmers, had only three years of rudimentary education, and performed the humblest of tasks in her convent. But she also was a mystic who was privileged to have many private revelations from our Lord. In obedience to her superior and spiritual director, she recorded these private revelations in six notebooks. Those notebooks are known today under the title: Divine Mercy in My Soul: Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska. The messages contained within her diary present profound communications from God for our day and age. Though the messages are many, there are several new ways that God is calling us to a new form of devotion.

- Through meditation on the image of Divine Mercy. 1.
- Through our participation in the Solemnity of Divine Mercy. 2.
- Through the recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. 3.
- By honoring Jesus' passion at the 3 o'clock hour. 4.
- Through an apostolic movement to spread the message of Divine Mercy. 5.

Though Saint Faustina died in 1938, we should see the messages in her Diary as messages God especially desires we learn and live today. God moves slowly and methodically. He first revealed these messages, then allowed them to be studied by the Church for decades, then led Pope John Paul to canonize her and establish the universal Feast of Mercy on the last day of the octave of Easter in the year 2000. For these reasons, we should see this as one of the newest and most relevant devotions in our lifetimes.

As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, ponder the profound significance of this new form of devotion for the Church and world today. The following is the 3 o'clock prayer Jesus gave to Saint Faustina:

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us (#1319). Jesus, I trust in You.


