Thank you to all the wonderful volunteers and organizers of St. Joe's Mulligan Festival, my first experience of it and I vote it a great bowl of soup and a success; now I wait to try Kieler's Mulligan.

"My flesh is true food and my blood true drink; he who eats my flesh and drinks my blood will live forever." The U.S. Bishops have called for a 3-year Eucharistic Revival and we are in the second year of it. The Diocese has purchased the Eucharistic Miracle display that is traveling around the Diocese and hosted the first ever Eucharistic Congress a few weeks ago. We are having a Parish Mission on the Eucharist, led this weekend by Bishop Hying: talks are Sunday at 7:00 pm and Monday at 6:00 pm in Dickeyville.

In conjunction with these efforts of the Eucharistic Revival, a year and a half ago I organized an Italian Eucharistic Miracles Pilgrimage. I will be leaving Monday, October 23rd and returning November 7th helping lead 42 pilgrims into a deeper encounter with our Eucharistic Lord. Please pray for a fruitful pilgrimage and know that I will be praying for all of you while we pray at the various sites: Siena, Orvieto, Lancia, Cascia (St. Rita), Assisi and Rome. God bless, Fr.
