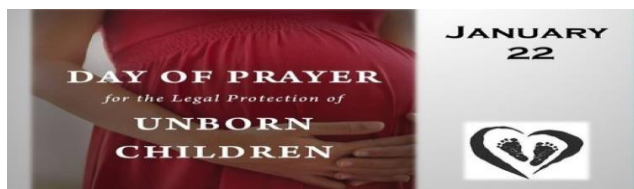
Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children is scheduled every year for January 22nd; every Catholic is asked to pray and fast on this day:
