# Mazzuchelli Musings

**T**hank you to all who helped and supported St. Patrick's Soup and Sandwich Dinner. The tabernacle at St. Patrick's was recently re-plated and looks very nice. Be Healed is the theme I'm focusing on for this Lent, it comes from Dr. Bob Schuchts' book *'Be Healed'*. The three main themes are:

1. Encountering Jesus
2. Facing Our Brokenness
3. Healing Our Wounds

"Healing is an essential dimension of the apostolic mission and of Christianity. When understood at a sufficiently deep level, this expresses the entire content of redemption." "[Jesus'] gaze, the touch of his heart heals us...enabling us to become truly ourselves and thus totally of God." Pp. Benedict XVI  
We all have a deep desire to be healed. "Why else do so many people spend a significant portion of their time, money, and energy in the pursuit of health and wholeness? According to the World Bank, health care currently consumes anywhere from 10-20 percent of our resources." *Healing the Whole Person*  
The Lord comes to us as he came to the paralytic at the pool of Bethesda (Jn. 5:1-9). "I'm sure Jesus approached this poor man with compassion, but I must admit I'm a bit troubled by his opening words: "Do you want to be well?"... The longer I ponder Jesus' question to this man, the more I begin to feel a bit uneasy myself. He is not just asking this lame man if he wants to be healed. His question is directed to me and to you as well. After all these years of struggling with our various physical, psychological, and spiritual infirmities, have we somehow resigned ourselves to our broken condition, believing "this is as good as life gets"? Have we also given in to hopelessness, believing we won't be healed? Most of the time, we aren't even conscious of our resignation. We just accept our condition and bear it as best we can. Can you relate?

Take a moment to examine your readiness for Jesus to heal you.  
What attitudes of doubt and unbelief stand in the way of you receiving Jesus' powerful healing love?"

## Catholic Corner

### The Ministry of Angels

#### First Sunday of Lent (Year B)

*The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert, and he remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan. He was among wild beasts, and the angels ministered to him. Mark 1:12-13*

**Reflection:** What an amazing event we reflect upon today. Jesus, the Son of God, the Second Person of the Most Holy Trinity humbled Himself in two ways in the passage quoted above. First, He allowed Himself to endure the temptations of satan. Second, He permitted His very own creation, the good angels, to minister to Him in His human form.

First of all, recall that satan is a fallen angel. He was created by God and was created good. But the Book of Revelation (12:4) indicates that one-third of the created angels were cast out of Heaven to roam the earth. These demons act under the direction of the highest fallen angel, satan. Thus, according to the passage above, it was satan himself who tempted Jesus in the desert. Additionally, Jesus permitted the good angels to minister to Him in His human nature. These acts reveal the perfection of the virtue of humility within the humanity of our Lord. According to Saint Thomas Aquinas, angels were created for three primary reasons. The first is for the purpose of worship. Second, angels enact the will of God in all things. Third, God uses angels as messengers.

Angelic beings have the ability to put before your imagination ideas meant to either influence you for the good (the good angels) or to deceive you and lead you into sin (the bad angels). These communications are real, and we should be aware of them.

**Prayer:** *My Lord, Please help me to be more aware of the deceptions of the fallen angels and the direction of the good angels. Jesus, I trust in You.*
