

Mazzuchelli Musings

Sin is an offense against God, self and others, "At the root of sin is the lie which is a radical rejection of the truth contained in the word of the Father. To reach it, it is not enough to stop at the surface of human actions. It is necessary to penetrate inside." St. John Paul II

We must move from resist to fix by <u>acknowledging our sin</u>, <u>confessing it</u> and <u>being humble</u>; we are to be perfect by grace and not by effort; the root of every sin is ungodly self-reliance because it turns us away from God and in on our self.

7 Deadly sins and their Idolatry

1)Pride- Self; 2)Envy – Status or Possessions; 3)Gluttony – Food or Drink; 4)Lust – Sex or Relationship; 5)Anger – Control; 6) Greed – Security or Wealth; 7) Sloth – Comfort.

7 Deadly Wounds and how they distort our Identity

1)Abandonment: "I am all alone. No one understands me."; 2)Shame: "I am bad, dirty, perverted...it's my fault." 3)Fear: "If I trust, speak, confront, I will be hurt or die."; 4)Powerlessness: "I feel overwhelmed...I don't know what to do." 5)Rejection: "I am not loved or wanted...I have no value." 6)Hopelessness: "It's never going to change...there is no hope." 7)Confusion: "I don't know what is happening to me." Sin not only causes wounds, it also grows out of wounds. We often sin in an attempt to escape the suffering caused by the wound. We need to examine the area of sin pattern and see behind the sin to the wound that is giving power to the sin.

What are our patterns of sin?

When we look at a wound: our response shouldn't be; "Why did this happen to me" but rather "what will I do about it now?" The latter supposes God's grace and power to heal and bring to newness of life.

Catholic Corner

Seeking the Full Truth

Jesus said to Nicodemus: "Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life." John 3:14-15

The line quoted above concludes a dialogue that Jesus had with Nicodemus, a Pharisee and a member of the Sanhedrin. This is the first of three times Nicodemus is mentioned in the Gospel of John. The second time he appears is when he reminds the other members of the Sanhedrin that a man must be first heard before he is condemned. The third time was when Jesus was killed and Nicodemus brought a mixture of myrrh and aloes to prepare Jesus' body for burial.

At the beginning of this dialogue between Jesus and Nicodemus, Nicodemus professes the beginning of faith in Jesus when he says, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God, for no one can do these signs that you are doing unless God is with him" (John 3:2). Interestingly, Jesus then speaks to Nicodemus in figures of speech, saying that one can only enter the Kingdom of God when they are "born from above" and "born from water and the Spirit." Nicodemus tries to understand but fails. Jesus then gently rebukes him by saying, "You are the teacher of Israel and you do not understand this?" (John 3:10). Jesus then goes on to speak further in symbolic language and figures of speech, concluding with the beginning of today's Gospel quoted above when He speaks in a veiled way about His coming crucifixion.

One thing that is important to understand from this dialogue between Jesus and Nicodemus is that Jesus' language is veiled in symbolic language because, even though Nicodemus was on the right path, he was not yet ready for the full revelation of the Gospel. He could not yet fully comprehend all that our Lord came to reveal. Thus, Jesus spoke in veiled language and invited Nicodemus to keep seeking its hidden meaning.

In our own lives, we can come to God and want Him to speak clearly and definitively to us, revealing His perfect will for our lives. But often He doesn't. Why? Because God knows we are not yet ready for the full truth. When He speaks to us and when we gain insight in one way or another, this is good and reveals we are on the right path.

Reflect, today, upon how open you are to the fullness of God's Word. Humble yourself, today, more fully before the mysterious Word of God and pray that you will continue to be changed and open so that the clarity of God's truth will more fully penetrate your soul.

My Lord, please continue to open my mind and heart to You so that, one day, I will understand Your Truth most fully. Jesus, I trust in You. (Source of Content: mycatholic.life)


