Mazzuchelli Musings

The Holiest Days of the Year happen this week with the Holy Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Vigil. I would encourage you to make every effort to attend these three days. The Passover defined who the Israelites were, so the Lord told them to celebrate it every year as a remembrance of what He did for them. This is the same for us celebrating the Holy Triduum; it's who we are and it should take priority over typical weekly activities. A few things to be aware of regarding Holy Week:

Living Stations of the Cross: Wednesday, March 27th at St. Rose Church at 7p.m.; students leading it.

Chrism Mass: Thursday March 28th at St. Maria Goretti in Madison at 10 a.m.

Good Friday: The collection on Good Friday goes directly to support Christians in the Holy Land.

The Divine Mercy Novena begins Good Friday; special conclusion at St. Mary's 1:30-4; April 7

Tenebrae: service that includes praying the psalms along with a light to darkness ceremony, no eucharist will be distributed at this ceremony.

Plenary Indulgences during Holy Week: are gained by recitation of *Tantum Ergo* during Eucharistic Procession on Holy Thursday, participation in veneration of the cross or doing stations of the cross on Good Friday, recitation of baptismal promises during the Easter Vigil. Three criteria need to be met to receive a plenary indulgence: reception of holy communion, sacramental confession within 8 days, and praying for the Pope; as well as detachment from all sin either venial or mortal.

New Patronal Name of the Pastorate: St. Dominic is often pictured next to a dog with a torch and it's because his mother had a dream during his pregnancy that a dog was running around the world lighting it on fire and it was interpreted that it was a prophecy of what Dominic would do through his life. It is believed that Mary appeared to St. Dominic and taught him the devotion of the rosary; he certainly was significant in spreading its devotion. St. Dominic started the Dominican Religious Order of which Ven. Fr. Samuel Mazzuchelli became a member and who then later started the Congregation of the Most Holy Rosary, better known as the Sinsinawa Dominicans.

Catholic Corner

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion—Solemnity

"Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the kingdom of our father David that is to come! Hosanna in the highest!" Mark 11:9

In today's Liturgy we face quite a contrast of experiences and emotions. We begin our celebration listening to the story of Jesus being welcomed into Jerusalem with great joy and exultation! "Hosanna!" they cried out. "Hosanna in the Highest!" Jesus was treated as He should have been treated. People were excited to see Him and there was much excitement.

But this excitement quickly turned to shock and horror as we enter more deeply into today's readings. The Gospel culminates with Jesus hanging on the Cross crying out "Eloi, Eloi, Iema sabachthani?" "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" And with that, "Jesus gave a loud cry and breathed his last." At that moment the entire congregation kneels in silence as we ponder the reality of Christ's death.

How things can change in one short week. What happened to all the people who were shouting and praising Him as He entered into Jerusalem? How could they allow Him to enter into this Crucifixion and death?

The deepest answer to this question is one that we may not expect. The answer is that the Father willed it. The Father willed, by His permissive will, that so many would turn on Him, abandon Him and allow Him to be crucified. This is so very important to understand.

At any time during that first Holy Week, Jesus could have exercised His divine power and refused to embrace His Cross. But He didn't. Instead, He willingly walked through this week anticipating and embracing the suffering and rejection He received. And He didn't do so begrudgingly or even with regret. He embraced this week willingly, choosing it as His own will.

Let this week give you divine hope. So often we can be tempted toward discouragement and, even worse, we can be tempted toward despair. But all is not lost for us either. Nothing can ultimately steal away our joy unless we let it. No hardship, no burden and no cross can conquer us if we remain steadfast in Christ Jesus letting Him transform all we endure in life by His glorious embrace of His own Cross.

Lord, when I am tempted to despair, give me hope. Help me to see your presence in all things, even in those things that are most troubling to me. May this Holy Week transform my darkest moments and weakness as I surrender all to You, my God. Jesus, I trust in You.

We will have the same presentation on three different evenings, once at each school.
