# Mazzuchelli Musings

**T**hank you to all who have contributed to the Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA). If you haven't, I'm asking that you please consider giving something, even if it's a little bit. The Diocesan staff do a lot of behind the scenes work that benefit the ministry we provide in the parishes.

Healing- Encounter Jesus

"I worry some of you still have not really met Jesus--- one to one--- you and Jesus alone....He loves you, but even more--- He longs for you." St. Theresa of Calcutta, *Letter to the Missionaries of Charity Family*

My journey of healing is minor in comparison to many but it's my story, everyone has one. I title this, the dumb farm kid that became a priest. I grew up relatively a happy kid in a good loving family but things happen in life that we interiorize a message about our self that isn't true. You name the list: last person picked on a team, getting a low grade, not catching the attention of the person you really admire, etc. While many in my life had done a lot to reaffirm my goodness and worth, the subtle lie that I'm not good enough and I'm dumb grew. I convinced others and myself that I was actually pretty cool but deep down grew the insecurity. While I was in seminary, prayer and being with peers who saw me for who I was began to chip away at this lie of being dumb, inadequate, and not really good. Like a leaky faucet, God the Father would find ways to speak to my heart, "you are my beloved", through reading scripture, going to confession, receiving His son in the Eucharist, or friends reaffirming my dignity. I was shocked to realize that when I shared my heart through talks, volunteer work, deep conversations, and serving others that I was appreciated and received; it also strengthened me. There was one retreat where I spent days receiving the loving gaze of Mary upon me as if I were Jesus; it was here that I began to realize the intensity of another's pure love for me. Later in that retreat, I received the gaze of Jesus as he hung upon the cross with His heart burning for me. Even when I was at my worst (sin), I was loved, appreciated, and valued; so many lies dispelled and knots untwisted for me. I still have a journey of healing and wholeness that Jesus desires for me to achieve. What's your story? Where are your wounds? God has a plan to use the circumstances of our life to draw us into our true identity which is found in His heart which created us.

### Glory Overshadowing the Cross

*Second Sunday of Lent (Year B)*

*Jesus took Peter, James, and John and led them up a high mountain apart by themselves. And he was transfigured before them, and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them. [Mark 9:2-3](#)*

Just six days prior to this glorious event of the Transfiguration, Jesus spoke for the first time to His disciples about His pending crucifixion and death. He taught them that "the Son of Man must suffer greatly and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and rise after three days" ([Mark 8:31](#)). Recall that Peter had a difficult time accepting this teaching. Jesus went on to rebuke Peter for his refusal to accept this prophetic teaching and further explained that "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me" ([Mark 8:34](#)). These disciples then had six days to ponder this prophecy of our Lord before witnessing the Transfiguration.

In your life, is there something that God is trying to say to you that you have difficulty accepting? If so, it will most likely be related to God's call to you to take up your cross and follow Him. The Cross of Christ comes in many forms throughout life. It might be experienced when we allow the passion of anger to die so that pure mercy can be offered to one who has hurt us. Or it might be that God is calling you to step out in faith to embrace some endeavor that requires courage and trust. Or it might be that God is calling you to accept some hardship in life that is difficult to accept, such as the loss of a loved one, an illness, the loss of a job or any other difficulty that you struggle to accept with love and trust. Bitterness, resentment, anger, fear and the like are often the most difficult crosses we are called to embrace and let die.

My Transfigured Lord, Please give me the grace and determination I also need to journey with You up the mountain of prayer so that I will be entrusted with the mission You give to me. Jesus, I trust in You.
